1. To Register for an OMJK-12 account go to www.education.ohio.gov ODE home page
 - a. Click on “Career Options for Students” Register for an account
 - b. 2nd way to register Go to www.ohiomeansjobs.com Click on “Individuals” Click on “cardinal with the mortar board hat. Click on “Get Started on my own” Register for an Account
2. Explore it (First Tab on OMJK-12 home page)
 - a. Career Cluster Inventory (80 responses; 4th grade reading level) See your handout for the 80 items
 - b. Career Profile (60 responses; 6th grade reading level) See your handout for the 60 items and the mnemonic “ERICAS” Enterprising, Realistic, Investigative, Conventional, Artistic, and Social
 - c. After completing the career profile inventory Click on “Explore it”, Click on “Career Profile”, Click on “View Careers” Click on an Occupation to reach the “Career Details” page for that occupation
 - d. Occupation Search Click on Search by Industry to get to “industry landing page”, or search by Key words (use job title “dishwasher”) or search by Education Level or search by Salary
 - e. Career Videos to teach occupations and skills
